We should all be so fortunate to have such opportunities. In collaboration with various organizations, The Regional Workforce Investment Board is comprised of many entities focused on the same goal. In terms of my professional, civic and volunteer experiences ... all have positioned me to participate in highly collaborative settings. My specific interest in serving on this board is simply because I am mission-driven. *Building a Future Ready Iowa* is paramount to the success of our state and nation and I support this both personally and professionally.

In 1993 I began my first-board term, serving three years as trustee on the Freedom Festival Board in Cedar Rapids. We were in the midst of transitioning what was once a single event focused on July 4<sup>th</sup> fireworks, into a 10-day celebration. *The mission is to celebrate the quality of life in Eastern Iowa by providing safe, affordable and fun annual events that embody the spirit of patriotism and a sense of community and family.* Today this festival is attended by 400,000 visitors and continues to embrace its mission.

As a classroom volunteer with Junior Achievement, I brought outside professional experiences into our 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms. A chance to work alongside certified educators supporting their curriculum goals provided me a first-hand view of how preparing our future workforce begins early. Helping youth understand their individual role in "our city, our state and our region" were specific topics JA covered. JA's mission reads: *We are empowering young people to own their economic success.* I served as a business mentor for 8 years and truly enjoyed the experience. JA is a valuable partner in public education.

Seldom does an opportunity present itself to be part of a groundbreaking faith group and my family was fortunate to be involved in such. Around 2000, I became part of a visioning committee to physically and spiritually construct a new parish outside of Fairfax. We among the first 10 families to join a parish, which 10 years later enjoys 750+ members. 14 years of teaching religious education with 2<sup>nd</sup> graders has allowed me to share my values with many 8-year olds. I was involved in capital campaigns for raising funds to build our church and continue to call on new members. My fundraising skills also were utilized by Mount Mercy University as an alumni-member of several capital campaigns for their college.

I was looking for a way to become more active in my community and was asked to consider running for a seat on our city council. After serving 10 years on our local Planning and Zoning commission I believed I could bring unique experience and perspective to the council. This endeavor has proved to be interesting to say the least and nearly ten years later I am still serving. After a "first-ever" in the state of Iowa, I found myself fulfilling dual roles of both Mayor and City Administrator simultaneously after the impromptu resignation of both officials. Fortunately for me my employer was supportive of civic duties and I was somehow able to balance three jobs. My personal mission statement for The City of Swisher, would be *"serving the residents of our community by providing amenities to preserve, protect and enhance our safe quality of life."*

Any time I am asked to consider a volunteer opportunity I find myself weighing the investment of my time against the outcome of my work. Double-checking my core values align with said mission helps me determine if such an opportunity is a good fit for me. If after learning more about my background and life experiences, your committee finds I would be an asset, I would quickly prove to add value to a Regional Workforce Investment Board.
